The XXI Century has witnessed a renewed interest by legislatures for civil codes. New codes are emerging in and outside of continental Europe while some of the great codifications of the past are being revised. What is the relationship between these new legislative products and the "classic" civil codes of the past? What lessons, if any, have today's legislatures learned from their past experiences? How are the new codes approaching features such as the level of abstraction of the rules, the systematization of private law and legislative interpretation? Has the role of civil codes in their respective legal systems significantly changed? How has legal methodology developed in continental European legal systems – such as those belonging to the Nordic legal family – that never adopted a civil code?
